Personal Statement up to 500 words outlining the reasons for pursuing a the professional development activity and its relevancy to the applicant's rural practice.

## Selection Criteria

### Eligibility

Member of CARRN (Adjudication Committee Members excluded)

Application fully completed post-marked or emailed no later than January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2008

Evidence of previous or pending course, workshop or conference registration/application scheduled between July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007 and June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2008.

## Assessment Criteria

Rural-Remote Practice Relevance

Length of CARRN membership

Preference given to applicants who have NOT received CARRN professional development award in previous 3 years.

## Award Outcome

Successful applicant to be notified by email by March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2008.

Successful applicant receives award funds following submission of activity receipt(s) and a brief review of activity (up to 250 words) for publication in newsletter by June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2008.
